1. Entry form
 - Entry forms need to be filled in online and send by email before the deadline. The organization reserves the right not to accept new registrations after the deadline. Additional fees will apply after the deadline.
No photo's accepted.
 - For AQHA - All participants in L1 classes Amateur, Youth (exhibitors) & Open(horses) must be able to confirm their leveling status if requested by the showoffice. You can find your levelling status at <http://www.aqha.com/services/leveling>. You need to be logged in.
 - For APHA - All participants must hold a novice amateur or novice youth card in addition to their regular APHA membership. Through this link you can check in which sections the participant in question still has novice status. For novice amateur to apply via:

- By sending in the entry form each owner/exhibitors acknowledges the announcement and the general terms and conditions.
 - For AQHA - Please send a copy of the AQHA registration papers and AQHA membershipcard for the AQHA classes. If this is not complete the registration can not be processed. No exceptions are made.

For NSBA - Please send a copy of the NSBA registration papers and NSBA membershipcard for the NSBA classes. If this is not complete the registration can not be processed. No exceptions are made.

For APHA - Please send a copy of the APHA registration papers and APHA membershipcard for the APHA classes. If this is not complete the registration can not be processed. No exceptions are made.
 - The host is not responsible for lost email which have not arrived.
 - Every participant will receive an entry confirmation and updated information. Each participant is responsible to check this information. Every participant is responsible for being on time before the class starts.
2. The host reserves the right to change the announcement until the entry deadline, change the date of show or cancel it if necessitated by certain circumstances. After the deadline, the final schedule will be published and might contain slight changes.
 3. In case of cancellation after the deadline, with a valid reason and a doctor's or veterinarian's statement, only the box – camping – membership(s) and office charge will be charged. If the participant is unable to provide the said statement or has not cancelled in time, the full costs will be charged.
 4. Each horse must be covered by liability insurance. From the vaccination record must be clear that the horse has had a first/base influenza vaccination followed by a yearly repeated vaccination. For horses born before January 1st, 2022, the first/base vaccination followed by a second vaccination within minimum of 21 and maximum of 92 days. Between the 1st and 2nd vaccination, the horse should not be competed. For horses born after January 1st, 2022, or receiving a new basic vaccination after January 1st, 2022, a basic vaccination consists of 3 vaccinations. Between the 1st and 2nd vaccinations must be a minimum of 21 and a maximum of 60 days. The 3rd vaccination should be given after a minimum of 120 days and a maximum of 6 months and 21 days. Between the 1st and 2nd vaccination, the horse should not be competed. A vaccination must be given at least 7 days before the show starts.
 5. Participation and attendance at the show is entirely at your own risk. Neither the Dutch Quarter Horse Association nor the Dutch Paint Horse Club nor the organization nor the location accepts any liability for loss, damage or theft of your horse(s) and/or property, nor for any injury suffered or death of a participating and/or present horse, rider or visitor during the entire duration of the show/event.

6. AQHA & NSBA Longeline and In Hand Trail is for 2- and 3-year-old horses. A horse entering those classes may not be entered under saddle. For APHA 3 & Older In Hand Trail the horse may not shown in a ridden trail class.

If there are less than three entries for Select classes at the time of the entry deadline, the respective class will be cancelled and integrated in the respective Amateur class. The open classes are junior and senior, if there are less than three entries in one of the classes the classes will be held together as a all-aged class.

7. AQHA & NSBA classes will be held class in class, except for the open Western Pleasure and Hunter Under Saddle.
8. It is not allowed to lunge or ride on the showground without a valid entry number. The whole facility, especially the warm-up pen will be checked on unsportsmanlike behavior (AQHA Rulebook VIO200-APHA GR-060). Longeing is only allowed at the indicated places.
9. Paynt Points is an incentive program that allows Amateurs, Youth Riders, Novice and Walk-Trot riders to automatically earn prize money by earning points at APHA competitions. Each participant pays €3 per start per judge.
 - €2 of this goes to the Paynt Points program.
 - €1 per start per judge remains a mandatory APHA contribution.APHA pays out based on the number of points earned in APHA classes.
10. To participate in the APHA walk&trot classes, you must hold an APHA walk&trot membership card. To participate in DPHC walk&trot classes, you must be a current DPHC Member.

Arrival

Arrival on Saturday April 26th, 2025. Not earlier, the stalls will not be ready. Stalls go in order of receiving of the registration form.

Openingstijden showoffice / Opening hours showoffice

The showoffice will be open Saturday April 26th from 16.00 till 18.00. And Sunday April 27th from 10.00 till 12.30 and 13.30 till 16.30. On show days the show office is open 1 hour before the show start and closed at 18.00. Changes can be made till 15.30 the day before the class takes place.

Paid Times

For each trail class, €15.00 will automatically be charged for the paid time trail. After the last trail class in Arena 2, the course will be changed to the next day's pattern. As soon as it is ready to go, you can ride the paid warm up trail yourself. Pay attention to each other and do not enter with too many people at the same time.

NQHA Euro Summit Circuit Champion

- *The title of NQHA Euro Summit Circuit Champion in AQHA/NSBA open classes will be awarded to the horse. The horse owner must be a current NQHA member.*
- *Titles in AQHA/NSBA Amateur, Youth or NQHA classes will be awarded to horse/rider combination. The rider must be a current NQHA Member.*
- *To determine a NQHA Euro Summit Circuit Champion you must show under all four judges and all results will be valued. In case of a tie, the tie judge will decide. The points will be calculated by the allround system.*
 - Place 1 receive 9 points*
 - place 2 receive 8 points*
 - place 3 receive 7 points*
 - place 4 receive 6 points*
 - place 5 receive 5 points*
 - place 6 receive 4 points*
 - place 7 receive 3 points*
 - place 8 receive 2 points*
 - place 9 receive 1 point.*
- *There have to be at least 3 Participants in each class for a circuit champion.*
